



POLICY NO.70

MUNICIPAL FLOATING DOCK POLICY

1. The floating dock is under video surveillance and this source will be used to determine time at the dock.
2. No person shall use the Municipal floating dock for commercial use or as a loading or unloading zone of a commercial nature, unless authorized by council (CAO).
3. No person shall dock or moor a boat at the Municipal floating dock for more than the allowable duration, twelve (12) hours. Once the initial twelve (12) hour period has elapsed the vessel is not permitted to return to the floating dock within a period of twenty four (24) hours.
4. No person shall loiter, create a public nuisance or consume alcoholic beverages on the municipal floating dock.
5. No person shall leave any trash, garbage or waste on the municipal floating dock.
6. Any boat docked, moored or left unattended, or obstructing use of designated areas after due effort has been made by the Municipality to notify the owner or operator, may be removed by the Municipality of the District of Barrington or a person contracted on its behalf for the purpose. The vessel owner shall be responsible for all associated costs of removal.
7. All use of the floating dock will be at the risk of the user, and the Municipality of the District of Barrington will not be held accountable for any damages related to the use of the floating dock.
8. Any violation of this policy, or other actions, that results in damage to the floating dock, and costs to the Municipality will be billed to the offender.
