January 31, 2006

### PURPOSE OF MEETING

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the allocation of funds to be received from the Federal Government from Gas Tax Revenues. At the previous evening's Council meeting it was suggested that a certain portion of these funds be allocated to the C.S.I. Sewer Committee. The Committee of the Whole Council wished to discuss how much of these funds should be allocated to that particular project.

A brief review of the Gas Tax Funding was done by the Clerk for the information of members. There is approximately \$927,000 estimated to come from Gas Tax Funds over a five year period.

Various formulas for funding the Cape Sable Island Sewer Project were illustrated and discussed by members. It was suggested that the Cape Sable Island Sewer Project should, in future, be dealt with by the Committee of the Whole Council rather than by a smaller committee since the project is of major significance to all of the Municipality.

It was the general consensus of members that approximately \$400,000 of the fund would be allocated towards the Cape Sable Island Sewer System. This allocation will be dealt with at the next meeting of Council.

### CLOSED SESSION

A brief Closed Session was held so that the Warden could inform members of the current negotiation for disposition of Municipal property through Team Shelburne County.

### ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned by mutual consent of members at 8:19 p.m.
