

The November meeting of the Municipality of Barrington Fire Advisory Committee was held on November 14, 2012 at the Island & BP fire hall.

The meeting was called to order at 7:19 pm by Chairman Dave Kendrick.

Departments present were; Woods Harbour Shag Harbour, Island & BP, Barrington, Port la Tour, and Port Clyde.

Warden Eddie Nickerson and Councillor Jody Crook were also in attendance.

The previous months minutes were read and a motion for approval was made by Troy Stoddard, seconded by Paul Thomas, carried.

Old Business:

Graham Dixon is finalizing the price for the municipal repeater system.

Dave Kendrick gave an explanation on certification of firefighting courses.

Clyde, Barrington and Port la Tour have all agreed to accept the municipal GOG's.

There was a lengthy discussion on firefighter training and NFPA standards.

New Business:

Motion made by Troy Stoddard to send the proposed GOG on training and helmet colors to the Chiefs of the departments and have the departments review it and bring back any concerns, seconded by Graham Dixon, carried.

Chiefs will bring their ideas on a municipal fire department to the next meeting after they have discussed it with their departments.

The Port Clyde department has voted unanimously that they are not in favor to the proposed amalgamation with Barrington and Port la Tour.

There was a discussion on the new training schedule.

It was decided that the committee would only recognize ISO 100, if the course was presented by an instructor.

The Warden gave a report on a proposed new policy for council to meet with the fire co-ordinator.
