SOG's are going to be reviewed by the fire co-ordinator and he will recommend any changes to be made. The municipality should then have the SOG's printed for each member in the municipality.

Graham Dixon will be drafting a Box Alarm System for the municipality, our fire co-ordinator will finalize the system and present it to all the departments.

Graham Dixon would like the municipal departments to cost share for programming equipment for pagers and radios, he will bring the costs to the next meeting.
