### PURPOSE OF MEETING

The purpose of this meeting was for members to consider the tender received for the Seal Island Light. Information has been obtained from the engineers concerning the integrity of the existing steel plate columns that support the domed roof. The correspondence received from CBCL Limited was read to the members of the meeting, and the written document was provided to the Warden for his review. During the conduct of the meeting he again read sections of the correspondence.

Having reached the hour of 10:00 p.m., it was the consensus of members that they continue their discussion until the business of the meeting was concluded.

After much discussion of the tender, it was agreed that further information should be obtained from the engineers, if possible. It was suggested that the engineers be asked if it is possible to assess the entire metal section of the Seal Island Light which is owned by the Municipality, to determine its structural soundness and any potential future concerns that may arise. The integrity of the metal portion of the Seal Island Light is a matter of concern to members as it may cause future repair expenditures. The engineers will be contacted to further investigate.

Having completed their discussion of the matter, the meeting was adjourned at 10:32 p.m.
