

Fire Service Advisory Committee March 13, 2013

The March meeting of the Municipality of Barrington Fire Advisory Committee was held on March 13, 2013 at the Island & BP fire hall.

The meeting was called to order at 7:12 pm by Chairman Dave Kendrick.

Departments present were; Woods Harbour Shag Harbour, Island & BP, Barrington, Port la Tour, and Port Clyde. Councillors El-Jaki and Crook were also in attendance.

The previous month's minutes were read and a motion for approval was made by Dwayne Hunt.

Old Business:

There was no old business discussed.

New Business:

A mock disaster will be held on April 21, 2013 in Upper Clyde.

A motion was made by Dwayne Hunt to set up a committee to try to tailor the training document from Chester to meet our needs, and bring it back to the Advisory Committee within two months. Motion was seconded by Johnny Nickerson. Motion was passed by all five departments present as well as the councillors present. Members for the committee will be; Johnny Nickerson, Brian Crowell, Dwayne Hunt, Franklyn Chetwynd, and Jody Goreham. Councillor Jody Crook and Dave Kendrick will also be on the committee.

A motion was made to table the discussion on SCBA until the next meeting when more information has been gathered on the new standards. Motion was made by Dwayne Hunt, seconded by Brian Crowell, passed by all five departments and two councillors.

There was a discussion on the by-laws of the committee and how the process worked when departments requested funding from council for equipment.

The Mobile Burn Unit will be in the Barrington area from July 3-7, 2013, this will give members of the departments the opportunity to take their live fire training and complete their level 1 training.

Motion made by Dwayne Hunt to have the Grants increased to \$35,000.00, motion seconded by Brian Crowell, carried by all five departments, while the councillors stated a conflict of interest.

A motion was made by Dwayne Hunt to create a committee to purchase ice rescue equipment, seconded by Paul Thomas, carried by all five departments, as well as councillors.

Councillor El-Jakl asked Dave Kendrick to get information from MFR services on refresher courses for our area.

A new level 1 course will be starting soon and members needing level 1 should contact Dave Kendrick.

Motion made by Walter Scott that all equipment to be sold should come to the FSAC to be discussed before it is sold outside the municipality. Motion seconded by Jody Goreham, carried by all five departments.

Motion made by Mike Swim to setup a committee to decide the structure of an amalgamated department. Motion seconded by Franklyn Chetwynd, carried by all five departments. Johnny Nickerson, Troy Stoddard, Brian Crowell, Troy Perry, and Mike Swim will be on the committee along with Jody Crook from council.

Motion made to adjourn by Walter Scott.
