There were 12 residents in attendance.

Residents had previously expressed concern to Council regarding ongoing issues at McGray Avenue with speeding cars and loitering. Residents were invited to meet with the Committee this evening to discuss matters of concern.

The main issues that were identified:

- Noise from vehicles (mufflers, revving engines, squealing tires, stereos, etc.)
- Speed of vehicles on McGray Avenue
- Drug use, mainly marijuana
- Loitering
- Commercial activity

As a result of the meeting the following proposed solutions were identified for further discussion at a future Committee of the Whole Council meeting:

- Turn off the Wi-Fi at the parking lot
- Addition of speed bumps or ripples to the parking lot or road
- Increased police presence
- No loitering signs (after hours)

The plan is to try and implement some of these proposed solutions and have a meeting again in two to three months to reassess.
