ORDER

WHEREAS Section 344 of the *Municipal Government Act* of the Province of Nova Scotia requires every property to be maintained so as not to be dangerous or unsightly;

AND WHEREAS the Council has reviewed the status of the property located at 2206 Highway 3, Barrington, NS, Assessment Account No. 03523241 and determined that the property is dangerous and unsightly.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the owner remedy the condition of the property by having the dwelling repaired or demolished and all debris removed and disposed of at an approved disposal site, and to fill in, or cover, any building foundations remaining on the property and obtaining all required permits necessary to carry out such work.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the well on the property be properly secured or filled in.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the owner fails to comply with the requirements of this Order within Thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, the Municipality of the District of Barrington may enter upon the property, without warrant or other legal process, and carry out the work specified in the Order at the owner's expense.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the owner may appeal the Order to the Council of the Municipality of the District of Barrington, in writing, within seven (7) days after the Order is made.
