Rest Stops / Picnic Areas

Accessibility Requirements

Waste Containers – within 41 inches from ground to opening.

- Picnic Tables
- 31.5 inches wide
 - 17 inches deep
 - 27 inches high
 - 79 inches clearance around table

Baccaro Lighthouse Picnic Park – Baccaro – May 5, 2023

- gravel parking lot – no designated accessible parking spaces
- grassed picnic area
- accessible waste container
- 2 benches
- 1 regular picnic table
- 1 accessible picnic table

Strang's Lane Rest Stop/Picnic Area – Port Clyde – May 5, 2023

- gravel parking lot – no designated accessible parking spaces
- grassed picnic area
- 1 regular picnic table on-site
- clear access to slipway

Fort Creek Park – Port LaTour – May 5, 2023

- gravel parking lot – no designated accessible parking spaces
- grassed picnic area
- waste container (accessible construction)
- 1 regular picnic table

Barrington River Rest Stop/Picnic Area – Barrington – May 3, 2023

Island View Park – Barrington Passage – May 3, 2023

- 5 benches

McGray's Avenue Gazebo and Boardwalk – North East Point – May 3, 2023

- accessible gazebo on site
- accessible waste containers

- accessible boardwalk
- 3 benches on boardwalk
