Centreville Baptist Church Food Bank

Food Banks Service to the whole area:-

The current Centreville Baptist Church Food Bank was established approximately 2 - 3 years ago. Initially it was just for the communities of Centreville and North East Point and we had very limited resources. However, it was brought to our attention that there were several needy families in the area.

We have a face book page {Centreville Baptist Church - Food Bank} where clients can find out what they need to know about the food bank. Anyone from the Barrington and Town of Clark's Harbour are free to come without showing need. (once every 2 week period). The Food Bank is open Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:30 until 1:30; no appointment necessary. There are limits on some items which are posted.

With donations of shelving from Home Hardware we now have 2 rooms (approx. space of 200 sq. foot each) where clients can shop for what they need just like at a small grocery store. We have 2 fridges where we can store milk, eggs, butter, yogurt, etc. and 5 freezers where we can keep meat, bread, pizzas, etc.

The two major grocery stores along with some other stores in the area with food products supply us with a major portion of our food. From them we receive discontinued, dented, crushed items, out of date or near outdated items (we have a sheet from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency [CFIA] which indicates how long different foods are good for beyond Best Before Date).

We have also received donations of food from food drives put on by local service groups, churches, schools and sport groups just to name a few. With that said we have purchased a lot of food items that aren't often donated. So far in 2022 we have spent almost \$18,000.00 on items like soups, canned milk, ketchup, mayonnaise, juices, coffee, sugar, etc. (we always shop when items are on sale).

The money that we use to purchase items not donated, comes from local service groups, individuals, churches, and businesses.

Without the donations of food and money we could not exist to help those that come to the Food Bank.

To date we have approximately 50 clients (each client usually represents more than one in the household) that come on a bi-weekly basis with at least 1 new person coming each week. In

addition to the clients that come to the Food Bank, we have individuals that take 7 banana boxes of food to Bay Vista Apartments and the Senior Apartments in Clark's Harbour each week on Thursdays.

All the people that work at the Food Bank are volunteers. Some that are involved on a regular basis are Nancy Smith, Martha Wickens, Barbara Thurber, Earle Goodwin, Robbie & Sharon Symonds, Warren & Bonita Nickerson and Bryden Smith. Others that help occasionally are Allison Atkinson, Ob Hopkins, Pastor Vincent Robertson, Edwin Allen, Linda Goodwin, Faye Cox and Brenda Flemming, just to name a few.

We are registered with Second Harvest through Sobeys.

We are in the process of registering with Food Banks Canada through Loblaws.

I can assure you that any money given to Centreville Baptist Church Food Bank will be used to purchase food for clients in our area and will be spent wisely.
