# RCMP Liaison to DOJ

## Mandate:

To liaise between RCMP and DOJ Public Safety and Security Division to oversee communications with clients and stakeholders on issues related to policing in Nova Scotia.

## Activities/Functions:

- Communication with Municipalities policed under the PPSA and related stakeholders
- Works to resolve issues in collaboration with DOJ and RCMP
- Addresses stakeholder inquiries, responds to formal correspondence, prepares briefing notes
- Available as a resource to stakeholders on policing agreements and the RCMP
- Collaborates with DOJ colleagues and other government staff on RCMP-related projects
- Liaises with RCMP (Strategic Planning) to share information and to collaborate on common policing files such as: Resourcing and Workload Analyses, Policing Reviews and Proposals, Reconciliation of Resources, Other Studies and Reports
- Preparation of Memoranda of Understanding and other Agreements
