PUBLIC PARTICIPATION MEETING – February 24, 2021

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE LAND USE BY-LAW RELATING TO LOBSTER STORAGE FACILITIES

The Planning Advisory Committee held a public participation meeting, pursuant to policy 68 Public Participation Program, on February 24, 2021 to collect public input on the proposed amendment, which include the addition of a definition for “lobster storage facility” and the approved zones and setbacks for these facilities.

There were no verbal or written comments or suggestions made by members of the public at the meeting nor prior. It is recommended that Council proceed with the proposed amendments.
