COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE COUNCIL MEETING, JANUARY 10, 2022

Municipal Boundaries Review

Section 369 of the Municipal Government Act requires councils to apply to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board in 2022 to confirm or to alter the number and boundaries of polling districts and the number of councillors.

It is recommended that direction be given to staff to commence the boundary review with the intention of retaining the status quo with minor changes being made where necessary and with particular attention being given to the boundary between District 2 and District 5 in the Oak Park – Riverhead area, as that boundary has caused some confusion to residents in the past.

BAY VISTA CROSSWALK – BARRINGTON PASSAGE

It is recommended that a letter be sent to the Department of Public Works requesting that they reassess the installation of a crosswalk in the vicinity of Bay Vista Apartments, in light of our perpetual requests, the recent accident and the number of housing developments and businesses, in that area.

REQUEST FOR STREETLIGHTS IN BARRINGTON PASSAGE

It is recommended that streetlights be installed on available poles in the Barrington Passage Business District from where Barrington Bay Trail crosses Highway 3 to T.L. Swaine's Garage.
