COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE COUNCIL MEETING, December 6, 2022

BGSAR Grant Request

The Barrington Ground Search and Rescue Association is requesting funding to assist with the purchase of a new vehicle. They have contacted all five municipal units in the county for funding and will be contributing 50% of the cost themselves.

It is recommended to Council to include \$14,400.00 in the 2023/2024 grants to organizations budget, to provide to the Barrington Ground Search and Rescue to purchase a new vehicle.

Centreville Baptist Church Food Bank Grant Request

The Centreville Baptist Church Food Bank is requesting a grant to assist with the cost of their operations.

It is recommended to Council to provide a grant in the amount of \$2,500.00 to the Centreville Baptist Church Food Bank, to be used specifically to purchase food.

Chapel Hill Museum Grant Request

A grant application has been received from the Chapel Hill Museum for a grant to assist with the cost of their operations.

It is recommended to Council to provide a \$500.00 grant to the Chapel Hill Museum.

2022-2025 Strategic Plan – Final Draft

A final draft of the 2022-2025 Strategic Plan was provided to members prior to the meeting.

It is recommended to Council to move forward with the 2022-2025 Strategic Plan with the word “Expand” changed to “Improve” in the title of goal 3.3 on page 9.

It is recommended to Council to request drainage improvements from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal to the area of the Island View Park parking lot.

Community Health Centre Conceptual Design

In advance of the meeting, members were provided with a conceptual design for a new Community Health Centre.

It is recommended to Council to proceed with the development of the detailed design of a new Community Health Centre, based on the conceptual design presented.

Appointment to Bay Side Home Board of Directors

It is recommended to Council to appoint Jamie Symonds and Tyson Ross as members of Bay Side Home Board of Directors.

Town of Clarks Harbour Canada Day Funding Request

It is recommended to Council to provide the Town of Clark's Harbour with a grant towards their Canada Day festivities in the amount of \$1000.00 from the special events budget.
