Fire Service Advisory Committee Oct. 8, 2014

The October meeting of the Municipality of Barrington Fire Advisory Committee was held on October 8, 2014 at the Island & BP fire hall.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Dave Kendrick.

Departments present were; Woods Harbour Shag Harbour, Island & BP, Barrington/ Port la Tour, and Port Clyde. Councillor Jody Crook was also in attendance.

CIS seminar, SCBA testing, financial statements, budgets, District Chiefs, driveway proposal, and amalgamation, were added to the agenda.

The previous month's minutes were read, and a motion for approval was made by Jason Shand, seconded by Brian Crowell, carried.

Old Business:

Kenn Baynton will be the I & BP's representative for RIT, the other departments will provide names at the next meeting.

New Business:

Dave Kendrick presented the list of municipal fire vehicles for review and discussion.

The assistant to the fire marshal's course has been cancelled until a later date.

The pump operator's course slated for the weekend will be cancelled if there is no new members signing up.

The IAFF will put on a Hazmat course in our area for free, but it will not be credited by the Proboard. Contact Dave Kendrick if anyone is interested.

Barrington/Port la Tour presented a proposal for a driveway for their proposed new hall. Motion made by Brian Crowell to put in a driveway at the new hall site, with money from the Capital Fund, all in favor. (Not in the motion but the quote Paul Thomas mentioned was from R&T Excavating Ltd for \$4,000.00 and HST \$600.00 for a total of \$4,600.00)

Motion made by Brian Crowell, for Port Clyde to purchase two Scott 2.2 SCBA's. Motion seconded by Jason Shand, carried.

Motion made by Brian Crowell to do away with the Station Chiefs, and go back to the way we were. Motion not seconded, declared dead.

Walter Scott is now Station Chief of Island & BP, with Mike Swim as District Chief. Mike Swim also expressed interest in reacquiring his position as Training Committee head.

There was a short discussion on Port Clyde and Ingomar Roseway unifying.

There was a discussion on Councils motion about building no new halls for two years.

The last of the firefighters that are signed with two departments were discussed, and it was decided which department these firefighters will be with.
