Fire Service Advisory Committee September 10, 2014

The September meeting of the Municipality of Barrington Fire Service Advisory Committee was held on September 10, 2014 at the Island & BP fire hall.

The meeting was called to order at 9:01 pm by Chairman Dave Kendrick.

Station Chiefs job description was added to the agenda.

Motion made to approve the agenda by Jason Shand.

Departments present were; Woods Harbour Shag Harbour, Island & BP, Barrington/Port la Tour, and Port Clyde. Councillor Jody Crook was also in attendance.

The previous month's minutes were read, and a motion for approval was made by Jason Shand, seconded by Paul Thomas, carried.

Jennifer Bell gave a report on the Fire Prevention Committee.

Mike swim gave a Training Committee report, and explained that he would be stepping down as Training Committee head.

Old Business:

A letter needs to be sent to Brian Holland telling him that Municipal departments aren't interested in the fire pump at Sherose Island.

Dave Kendrick explained the RIT Standards, and explained that RIT requires a lot of training.

Motion made to set up a RIT committee, and have each station will supply names for the committee. Motion made by Mike Swim, seconded by Jason Shand, carried.

Mike Swim asked for the definition on the Station Chiefs job. Dave Kendrick explained that the District Chief had the ultimate authority at a fire, but it was thought that the Station Chief looked after their station.

Motion made to wait until this winter to change the SOG's to accommodate that station chief looks after the station and District chief looks after the fire. The RIT SOG's will also be changed at this time. Motion made by Mike swim, seconded by Paul Thomas, carried.

Motion made by Mike Swim to take passenger vans and SUV's out of the mix as fire vehicles, seconded by Paul Thomas, carried, one against.

A preliminary list of vehicles in the municipality was compiled. Dave Kendrick will complete the list and send it out to the departments.

There was a discussion on department membership papers for members. Firefighters have to be signed members of their departments to qualify for insurance.
