

Fire Service Advisory Committee April 10, 2013

The March meeting of the Municipality of Barrington Fire Advisory Committee was held on April 10, 2013 at the Island & BP fire hall.

The meeting was called to order at 7:14 pm by Chairman Dave Kendrick.

Departments present were; Woods Harbour Shag Harbour, Island & BP, Barrington, Port la Tour, and Port Clyde. Councillors El-Jakl and Crook were also in attendance.

The previous month's minutes were read and corrected and a motion for approval was made by Paul Thomas, seconded by Walter Scott, carried.

Old Business:

There was a discussion on the Training Standards Committee Meeting, and what has been decided thus far at the meetings.

The minutes from the two Unification meetings were read and discussed.

The mock disaster in Clyde will begin at 8:00 am and run until about 11:30 am and will have a debriefing.

The report on municipal SCBA showed that many of the SCBA in the municipality will be out dated when the new standards are put in effect.

There was a discussion on what will be needed along with the MBU for students to have their live fire course completed. They will need a van to burn and a dumpster.

MFR courses can be scheduled online through MFR Services on the internet.

An increase request was sent in for the municipal grant, this has to be voted on by council.

Motion made by Robert Hubbard that information should be gathered on the new SCBA standard, and brought back to the next meeting, seconded by Gene Stoddard, all departments agreed.

New Business:

There was a discussion on removing the municipal policy of showing the fire rate on tax bills in the municipality; this was tabled until after the Unification meeting are completed.

A motion was made by Walter Scott to request that public works look at the site of the proposed water hole in Woods Harbour, and bring back an estimate to the next meeting. Motion was seconded by Jody Goreham, all departments were in agreement.

The new level 1 course was discussed, a motion was made by Walter Scott to table the start of the new course until after the completion of the Training Standards committee have made their recommendations Motion was seconded by Paul Thomas, all departments in agreement.

The ICS-200 course will be rescheduled to MAY 11th & 12th , 2013.
