

BARRINGTON MUNICIPAL FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICE

Fire Service Advisory Committee January 21, 2015

The January meeting of the Municipality of Barrington Fire Service Advisory Committee was held on January 21, 2015 at the Island & BP fire hall.

The meeting was called to order at 8:38 pm by Chairman Dave Kendrick.

Departments present were; Woods Harbour Shag Harbour, Island & BP, Barrington/Port la Tour, and Port Clyde. Councillor Jody Crook was also in attendance.

A letter from WSHS, sale and purchasing of equipment, SCBA cylinder testing, building a new hall, sale of trucks, were added to the agenda.

Motion made to approve the agenda by Walter Scott.

The previous month's minutes were read, and approved.

Old Business:

Names for the Duties committee for District and Station Chiefs are: Garnett Sullivan, Gordon Ross, Paul Thomas, and Rob Hubbard.

Names for the committee on Rapid Intervention Team requirements are: Shannon Newell, Kenn Baynton, Brian Crowell, and Johnny Nickerson.

New Business:

The flow tests for SCBA will be done on February 17 and 18 by Mic Mac Safety Source. The SCBA will be tested at WSHS hall, I & BP hall, and Port Clyde hall.

We will try to get the MBU in our area in September or October. Dave will call the school to confirm the dates.

Departmental Treasurers will have to sign the necessary paper work for the Municipal Clerk-Treasurer to collect the HST.

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Dave Kendrick presented a list of items that require a purchase orders. Dave explained how the purchase orders will work and how they will be filled out.

Motion made by Paul Thomas to sell PLT Trucks # 52 and 53, and the old rescue from Barrington. The department also wants to sell SCBA cylinders, and the money from the sales would go to a MFR vehicle. Motion seconded by Brian Crowell, carried.

Correction to the above Motion; It should have read truck 50, & 52 Mistake by Paul on the numbers. (Added by David Kendrick)

There is no water in the stand pipe system at the municipal building.

Policy 54 has been amended to note surplus or deficits in department's budgets. Surpluses can be placed in a fund for their use at their **(Council's)** discretion. Deficits have to be paid back on the next year's budget.

Motion made by Paul Thomas that we ask council to supply the crests for the departments. Motion seconded by Walter Scott, one against, motion carried.

Woods Harbour Shag Harbour presented a letter notifying they would no longer be a member of the Barrington Municipal Fire & Emergency Service, or the FSAC.

Motion made by Jody Crook for the FSAC to consult a solicitor to see if WSHS could leave the FSAC and BMFES. Motion seconded by Troy Stoddard, two against, motion carried.

A lengthy discussion ensued on this subject of WSHS leaving the FSAC and BMFES.

Motion made by Shannon Newell to have WSHS's SCBA cylinders hydrostatic tested. Motion seconded by Brian Crowell, one against, motion carried.

Island & BP will offer some equipment for sale and municipal departments will get first offer.

Motion made by Paul Thomas for Island & BP to purchase \$2800.00 worth of equipment. Motion seconded by Brian Crowell, carried.

Motion made by Jody Crook to have a solicitor look at the deed of the old Port la Tour hall before they have it torn down. Motion seconded by Walter Scott, carried.

Motion made by Walter Scott to have training waved for Station Chiefs until the end of 2015. Motion seconded by Brian Crowell, carried.

Motion made to adjourn by Walter Scott.
