PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAW NO. 25, -
TAX EXEMPTION BY-LAW

Barrington Municipal Council is considering amendments to Schedules “A”, “C” and “D” of By-Law No. 25, “Tax Exemption By-Law”.

Schedule “A” will be amended by adding “Agape Café Youth Ministry” which is a non-profit organization that owns property in Barrington Passage. By being added to this by-law they will be exempt of the responsibility for payment of rates and taxes, exclusive of area rates, sewer charges, services charges, and any other special levies.

Schedule “C” will be amended by deleting references to properties formerly owned by the Barrington/Port LaTour Volunteer Fire Department and by adding the Assessment Account Number of the property currently owned by the department.

Schedule “D” will be amended by adding two more properties owned by the Cape Sable Historical Society, located in Barrington.

Proposed amendments may be inspected at the Municipal Office, in the Administrative Centre, located at #2447, Highway #3, Barrington, N.S., between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Any representation by interested persons concerning the proposed amendments to By-Law No. 25, “Tax Exemption By-Law” may be made at the August 28, 2017 Council meeting, which will be held in the Council Chambers, in the Administrative Centre, in Barrington, N.S. Proposed amendments to the by-law will be discussed at 7:00 p.m.
