1. GENERAL
- 1.1 The work shall include all labour, equipment, materials and incidentals necessary to provide the preparation and second lift paving on the Parking Lot at McGray Avenue within the Municipality of the District of Barrington.
- 1.2 Finished asphalt surface have minimal irregularities when checked with a straight edge placed in any direction.
- 1.3 All on site signage and traffic control is the responsibility of the Contractor. Flagmen and signage are to be provided in accordance with the Nova Scotia Department of Labour's Temporary Workplace Traffic Control Manual, latest edition.
- 1.4 The Contractor shall guarantee his work against any defects/ defaults including bleeding, shoving, slippage, cracking, or rutting for a period of one full year from date of acceptance of the work including the date of acceptance of any corrected deficiencies.
- 1.5 The Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless the Municipality against and from all damages, claims, suits, demands, actions, judgements, and cost of any kind and description as a result of injury or property damage resulting from the performance of this tender or through any improper or defective equipment used by the Contractor or through any act or omission on the part of the Contractor, his employees or sub-contractors.
- 1.6 The Contractor shall be paid at the full completion of the project.
- 1.7 Contractors submitting tenders will only be considered if the required Submission Tender Forms are fully completed and returned to the Municipal Office at 2447, Highway #3, Barrington, prior to the submission deadline.

## 2. PROJECT DETAILS

- 2.1 Project will be to prepare and pave a second lift on the parking lot at McGray Avenue, within the Municipality of the District of Barrington. This parking lot is the property and responsibility of the Municipality of the District of Barrington.
- 2.2 The McGray Avenue Parking Lot Second Lift Project is to consist of the following:
- second lift of 1.5 inches of pavement, compacted.
  - parking lot is to be cleaned and repairs carried out to existing pavement prior to installation of second lift.
  - existing pavement at entrance and exit is to be evened out.

## 3. DISCLAIMER

- 3.1 The Municipality reserves the right to reject any and all tenders, to waive any and all formalities or informalities, and to disregard all non-conforming, non-responsive or conditional tenders. In addition, the Municipality reserves the right to negotiate contract changes with the finalist tenderer, and/or to award a contract to any tenderer in the Municipality's sole discretion. The Municipality reserves the right to reject the tenders of any and all proponents if the Municipality believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Municipality to make an award whether because the tenders are non-responsive or because the tenders are found to be not responsible or fail to meet any other pertinent standard or criterion established by the Municipality.

The Municipality may conduct such investigations as the Municipality deems necessary to assist in the evaluation of any tender, to establish the best tender and to otherwise make its selection.

4. TENDER EVALUATIONS

- 4.1 The tenders will be evaluated by representatives of the Municipality of the District of Barrington in their sole discretion.
- 4.2 The lowest or any tender may not necessarily be accepted. Such things as past performance, workmanship, references, and start/ completion dates will be taken into consideration when awarding the tender.
