I have many years of experience in the land development and construction industry. Before moving to Toronto, I worked in the Planning Department of the Nova Scotia Department of Housing, the provincial agency responsible for the delivery of public housing for family and senior citizens. I worked in the Planning and Co-ordination Section under the direction of the architect who designed the projects and the planning technician responsible for ensuring compliance with all land use by-laws. I was also the Coordinator of the Neighbourhood Improvement Program, a tri-level government funded initiative to replace and upgrade municipal infrastructure throughout the province. The program was run in 23 municipalities, and I had the privilege of travelling all over the province with my federal counterpart to inspect the projects for which funding had been requested.

In Toronto I worked for a number of residential home builders as well as two and a half years at a law firm that specialized in real estate and corporate law. My experience ranges over all areas of land development from land acquisition, financing, development approval processes, sales and marketing, and legal transactions. My major area of responsibility has been aiding the planning consultant process development approvals through the various municipalities, utilities, conservation authorities, and outside agencies such as school boards. I was the company liaison with all consultants, municipal departments, planning consultants, architects, engineers and handled clearing draft plan conditions and registering site plan agreements, condominium and subdivision plans.

I have a certificate of Small Business Management from Dalhousie University, law clerk certification from Seneca College and until I moved back to Nova Scotia, I was a licensed real estate representative. I was a director on the board of the Canadian Association of Women in Construction from 2011-2016, during which time I served as Treasurer, Chair of the Bursary Committee, and a member of the ad hoc committee for CAWIC's Level Best Women's Advancement Project, a federally funded research and action plan designed to improve women's advancement into leadership roles within the Canadian construction industry.

I have always enjoyed working in the land development and construction industry. It would be my honour to participate on the Planning Advisory Committee and see the implementation of both short-range and long-range planning to enhance the quality of life throughout the Municipality.
