### APPROVAL OF AGENDA

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

### REVIEW OF LAST MEETING

The ICSP Planner, Karen Dempsey, reviewed the previous discussions concerning the Barrington and Barrington Passage Rural Centres. She also reviewed proposed Residential General zoning changes suggested for the community of Centreville, North East Point from the Causeway to Drinking Brook Park, the Sand Hills and Sebim Beach area, the Port Clyde area, and the Station Road area in Shag Harbour.

RECREATION AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES

Zoning various areas for recreation purposes was then discussed. This included the municipal property owned on Sherose Island and other municipal properties used as parks, as well as various privately owned areas used for recreational purposes such as ballfields, and trails.

Members also discussed the provision of civic addresses at various recreation facilities for the purposes of emergency service vehicles.

**Moved** by S. Hatfield and seconded by M. Atkinson that it be recommended to Council that municipal recreational facilities be identified and assigned civic addresses, as required, to facilitate Emergency Services' responses to those properties.

TRANSPORTATION

The Transportation Policy in the Municipal Planning Strategy was also reviewed in light of the policies also contained in the Integrated Community Sustainability Plan.

There was some discussion of revision of the subdivision road requirements in the Municipality. This matter will be addressed when the Subdivision By-Law is considered for review.

Members were informed that a letter of resignation has been received from Michel Melanson who is the mapper employed by the District Planning Commission. Michel's employment will be terminated October 28<sup>th</sup>. He has accepted a position at the Nova Scotia Geomatic Centre in Amherst.
