### PUBLIC PARTICIPATION MEETING RE: LAND USE/REZONING APPLICATION – KEN ANTHONY

Chris explained the process to have the MPS/LUB amended to the 16 members of the public in attendance.

Two written letters were read by the Chair as well as a written statement from a member of the public in attendance. Several members of the public spoke to the PAC as well. It was the consensus of the public in attendance and the written letters that they do not want the MPS/LUB amended to allow lobster holding facilities, lobster pounds, lobster tank houses in CG Zones. Various reasons were given including: the high level of traffic in the area already, the smell, the noise, the hours of operation, the impact on the environment, the devaluing of neighbouring land,
